My Master of Science in Environmental Health included studies in air pollution modelling, interpretation of toxicological and epidemiological studies, risk assessment and management. My MSc dissertation was on "Hearing loss in army farriers."

My professional diploma in Environmental Health included studies of pathology, disease causation, risk assessment and management, air pollution modelling and measurement, enforcement of environmental protection (including nuisance) law, and enforcement of health and safety law.

My professional Diploma in Occupational Hygiene, included studies of risk assessment, health effects of hazardous agents, modelling and monitoring of exposures, evaluation of health effects from exposure, and health and safety law.
